Research Conference held at Shalamar Medical and Dental College on 21st April 2026.

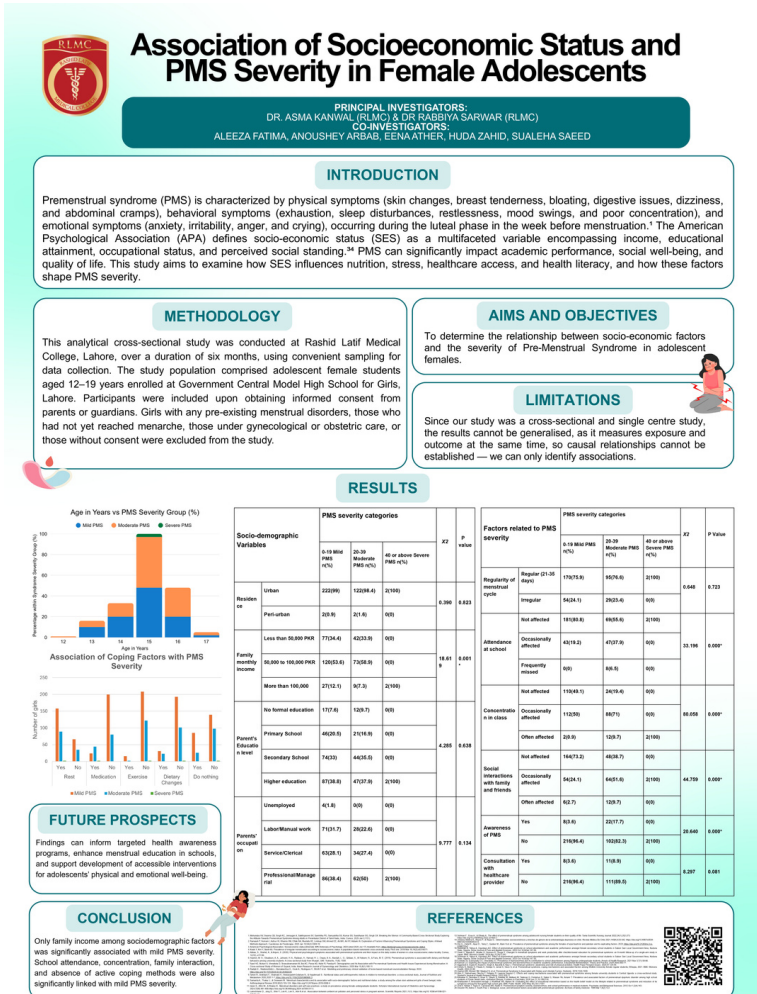


Image 1. Poster titled “Association of Socio-Economic and Pre-Menstrual Syndrome Severity Status in Female Adolescent”

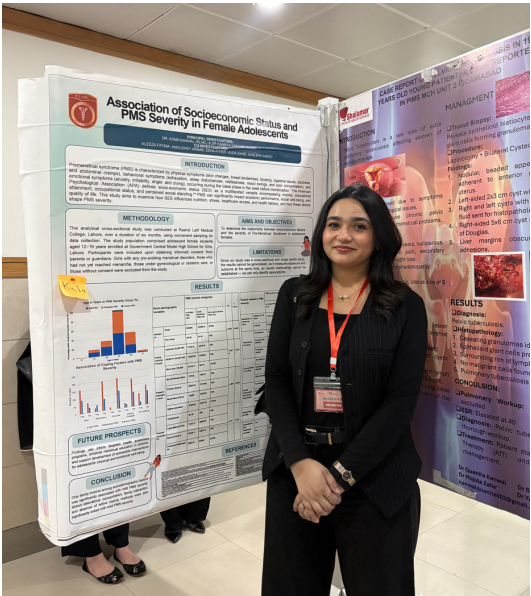
