CRITICAL ERRORS

Any error warrants a NO PASS COMPETENCY grade

- Fails to record any aspect of the medical history which may interfere with the treatment of the patient.
- Fails to or improperly summarize patient's dental history.
- Improper terminology of disease/site/landmark.
- Fails to appear presentable as per department rules and regulations while handling a patient.
- Does not correlate the medical history to the oral features.
- Does not properly examine the patient, extra-orally or intra-orally.
- Does not possess knowledge of the investigations required to diagnose the presenting condition.
- Is not able to correctly form a provisional diagnosis.
- Does not discuss proper treatment options including pharmacological management with the proper dosages required.
